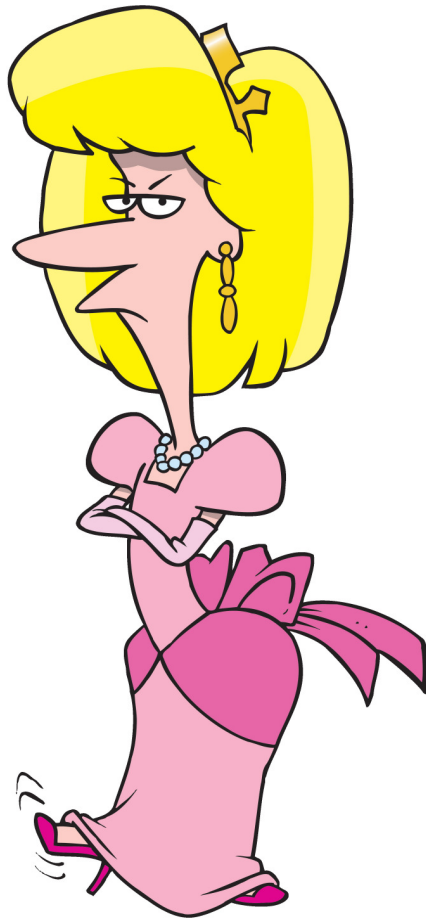

Our boom town's growing, quick, quick, quick!









