Assembly

Materials:

- ◆ Category cards (ew, ue, ui, u-e, short u CVC, short u CVCC)
- ◆ Point cards (100, 200, 300, 400, 500, Bonus)
- ◆ Answer cards (definitions only)
- ◆ Answer key for teacher (attached)
- ◆ Large pocket chart
- ◆ Score sheet

To play

- ◆ Player/team chooses category and point value.
- ◆ Teacher turns the answer card over and reads the definition
- ◆ Student/team then provides the answer in question format and spells the word.

Ex: Student: "I'll take long u for 100."

Teacher: "Color of the sky"

Student: What is blue? b-l-u-e.

- ◆ Bonus round: Each student/team chooses a bonus question and makes a wager from their points.
